- Busara Center, Kenya: 16 hours of work down to 30 minutes for participant coordination
- ActionAid, Isiolo, Kenya: 24 field trips per month down to 12 for basic M&E data-gathering
- St. Gabriel's Hospital, Malawi: \$3,500 and 2100 hours of staff time saved in one summer
